## CALLED INTO THE WORLD

Kairos means the right or opportune time selected by God for something to happen - the perfect time. God's special time.

Kairos is a ministry of the church ... a ministry of the apostles whom Jesus, the Christ, has called into community and sent forth into the environment of the correctional institution. Kairos has been called the best example of the early church in existence today.

The next Kairos Prison Ministry weekend at Limestone Correctional Facility will be from April 22-25. This will be the fiftieth weekend (with the weekends spread over about 25 years) that an interdenominational team of 65-70 volunteers from approximately 30 churches and numerous denominations has taught a basic course in Christianity to 42 inmates at this prison.

During these special times chosen by God, over 2000 local inmates have been taught the basics of Christianity, and many of their lives have changed forever as they learned about Jesus Christ and His salvation, grace, love, and mercy. God's Kingdom has grown, and our society is a better place to live.

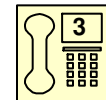
